Went for a walk by the lake this week, it was really peaceful and a nice change to get some fresh air.



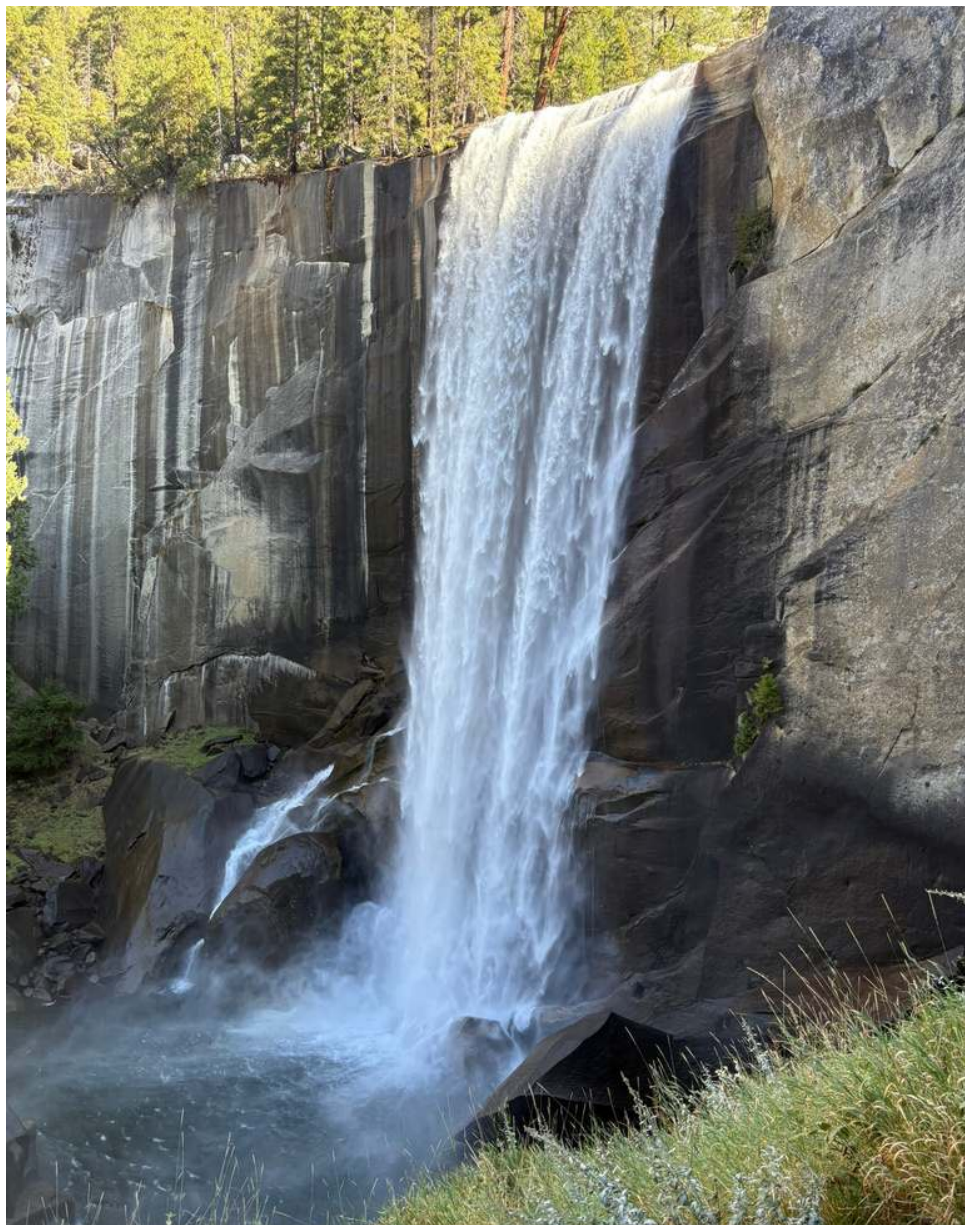
WILL

RACHEL



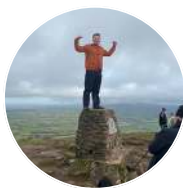
RACHEL
